

Ulrike Volkhardt

Master Class, Special Session and Big-blow – Sunday 15th June 2025

Ulrike Volkhardt is making a short visit to Australia in June. Ulrike tutored at the VRG 2015 Spring weekend. She founded and directs the ensembles *camerata moderna* (Baroque music ensemble), *Ut Re Mi* (recorder ensemble), *devotio moderna* (schola and instrumental ensemble for medieval music), and ensemble *miroirs* (contemporary music/performances). From 1994 to 2022, Ulrike was Professor of Recorder and Historical Performance Practice at the Folkwang University of the Arts, Essen. She has appeared as a soloist, and with orchestras and at festivals internationally.
